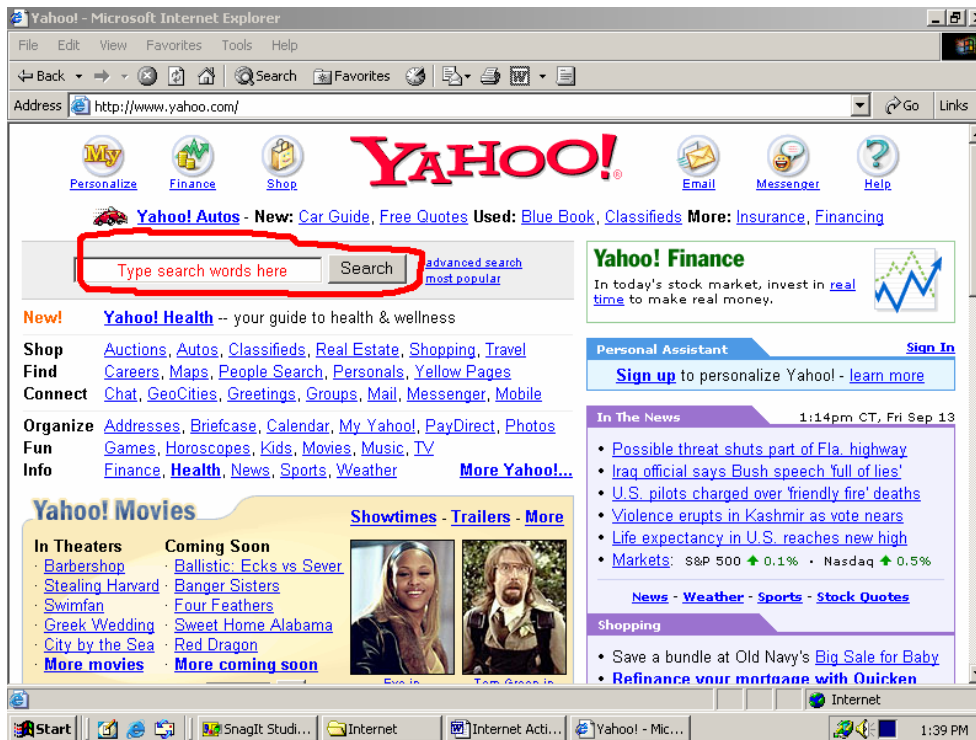


Internet Explorer: Exercise 3

In this exercise:

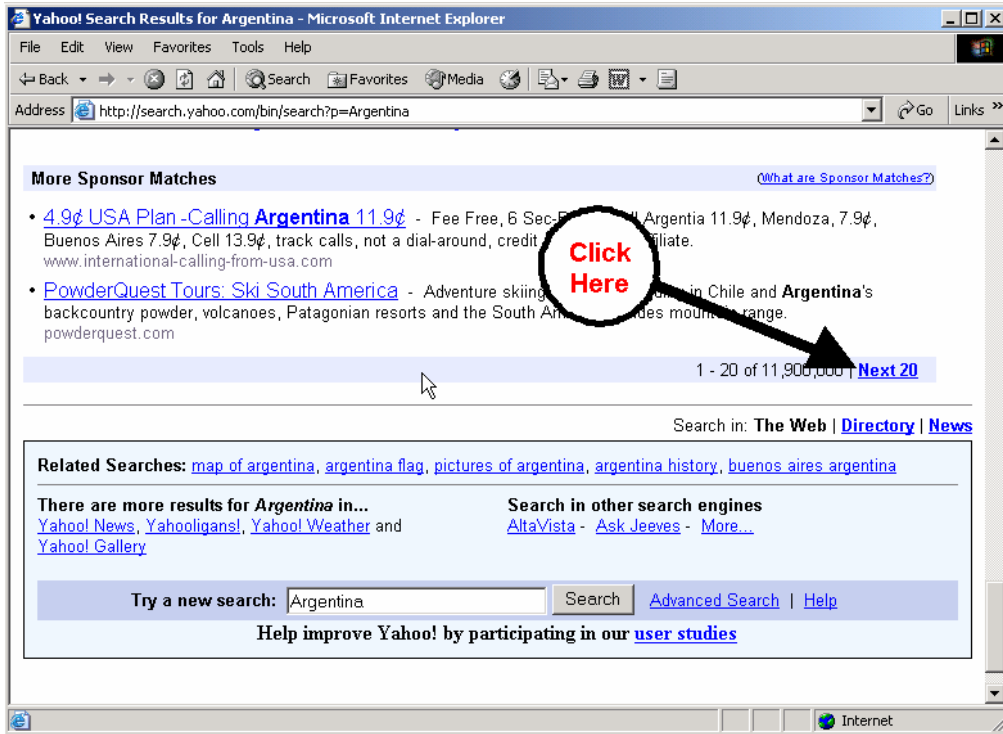
- How to use search engines

1. Click in the address bar. Type www.yahoo.com.



2. Click in the search box. Type the state or country that you are from.
3. Click on **SEARCH**. The search engine (Yahoo) will find all of the webpages that have your state or country in them.
4. How many pages are listed? _____
5. Scroll through the list and read the descriptions.

6. At the bottom of the page click on **Next 20** to see even more webpages.



7. Choose a site by clicking on the underlined part. What is the URL (internet address) for the site? _____

8. Now, **Click** on the **BACK** button. In the search box type the state or country and Festival.

Examples: **Thailand and festival**

Minnesota and festival

9. Yahoo will find all the web pages that show BOTH the name of your country or state and the word *festival*.

10. Choose a site by clicking on the underlined part. What is the URL (internet address) for the site? _____

11. Now try your own search. What keyword will you use? Write it in the field below.

12. Now type the word you have chosen in the box on the screen. **Click** on **SEARCH**

13. Choose one of the websites described in the list by clicking on it.

14. Try clicking on several website listings until you find one that you like. What is the URL for that website? _____
