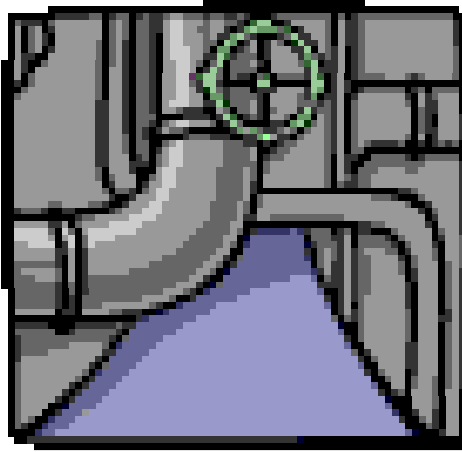


Classes for **ADULTS**

Special Low Pressure Boiler License



What the class offers:

This course leads to a state special license which is the first stop needed to operate a boiler. A boiler and related equipment provide steam or hot water for large buildings. Such as, office buildings, apartments and industrial buildings.

The course will cover:

- Vocabulary words around low pressure stationary steam boilers, tools and manuals.
- Processes to operate or tend to steam boiler and steam equipment
- Participation in field trips
- Development of better communication and work readiness skills.

 - TABE D Reading test 6.0-12.5
 - CASAS Reading test 236+
